- Scholarship Amount: \$ 500.00
- All applications must be received by Monday May 12, 2008

- Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of: contents of essay, community involvement, school activities, and letter of recommendation.
- Applicants must write a five hundred word (approximately) essay on their short and long-term goals and how the scholarship will help them achieve those goals.
- Award winner will be notified by phone prior to senior award day at school.
- Official High School transcript is required.

Scholarship Awards:

- A check will be sent to the college or trade school between June 1st and October 1st.
- Recipient must supply proof of enrollment from the college or trade school, address and information before check can be issued.
- All checks shall be made payable to the college or trade school.
